

Carl Sobieralski has been a forensic scientist for the Indiana State Police (ISP) Laboratory since 1990. He has performed casework in Serology, DNA, Blood Spatter, Hair analysis, Arson, Lamps and Glass. He actively works Clandestine Lab crime scenes as a certified Lab chemist. He has processed over 400 clandestine labs. Mr. Sobieralski also has testified over a hundred times in criminal matters. He was one of the original members in the DNA unit. His job duties in the biology unit include functioning as the ISP DNA technical Leader, supervising forensic DNA analysts, overseeing the training program in biology, and working to improve the quality system. He has been involved in all the validations for DNA analysis in the Indiana State Police Laboratory. He has helped develop the procedures used in the ISP laboratory. Mr. Sobieralski is certified as a diplomat by the American Board of Criminalistics. He also is an assessor that reviews other laboratories forensic biology programs. He performs these functions for the American Society of Crime Laboratory Directors/ Laboratory Accreditation Board, National Forensic Science Technology Center, and Forensic Quality Services International. He has assessed the programs in over 60 forensic labs around the country.
